The Board consists of young people and adult professionals with a specific area of knowledge e.g. health, police, schools, councils and voluntary organisations. The views of young people help the stakeholders understand what young people want to do, what services are needed and where.

Young Commissioner meetings take place on evenings, weekends and school holidays.

Transport & refreshments are provided for all YC meetings.

Ideally young commissioners will attend at least half of the meetings. They are arranged to suit everyone's availability.
