Group 1 - What does good look like

- Personal and professional responsibility to stay up to date and find out what's going on
- Need for local authority to give good quality input / feedback
- Need for local authority to identify what they want to get from the Forum
- Need to obtain inclusive contributions / consultations (NCC not to be selective in who they approach)
- Clear links between strategic groups (where they are real)
- Reps to give brief feedback at each Forum meeting
 - Highlight reports
 - Theme / subject links of meetings on website
 - email with links
- Not just ticking boxes to satisfy NCC needs
- Strategy group consolidation
- Feedback from the strategic board

Group 2

- Feedback
 - action / tracker page with NCC
- Profile raising
 - news creation
 - use of social media – to increase hits to the website
 - Enews links
- Minutes / reports need to be more prompt

Group 3 – What would good look like?

- Presentations are all interesting but need to ask presenters to include an explanation about how a child or young person will access and experience the service
- More of the bigger tables rather than 'billy no mates on your own, on the little tables at the back of the room'
- When introducing ourselves include a 'one liner' to explain your service and the area it covers/ age range you support'
- List of members on website –including contact name, area they cover, key words to illustrate core business

Group 4 – what would good look like?

- Feedback needs to be accurate and timely
- Attendees list to be published before and after the meetings
- Encourage more case studies
- Information sharing should be more focused on voluntary sector
- List more information on delivery and people (from groups)
- Presentations from extended / other areas e.g. young Scott
- Split statutory and voluntary presentations
